DIFC's New Data Protection Law

As reported by Dubai's official media house, the Dubai International Financial Centre (DIFC) Data Protection Law No.5 of 2020 (Law) has been enacted by His Highness, the Ruler of Dubai. Additionally, new data protection regulations that set out the procedures will be available publicly shortly.

The Law will be effective from 1 July 2020, with a grace period of three months, until 1 October 2020, for the businesses to comply with it, after which it will be enforceable.

Clearview AI sued for facial recognition

A class action lawsuit is filed in Court of Illinois by the American Civil Liberties Union against Clearview AI, a facial recognition technology company under Illinois Biometric Information Privacy Act, 2008.

It is alleged that Clearview is violating Illinois residents' privacy rights by storing individuals' biometric information without their knowledge.

Clearview's facial recognition tool is also used by law enforcement and private businesses to search for persons using their images.

Danish watchdog fines JobTeam

JobTeam, a staffing and recruitment company has been fined DKK 50,000 by Datatilsynet, the Danish data protection authority for not complying with basic requirements under General Data Protection Regulation.



Social network fined for "invite contacts" function

The Belgian Data Protection Authority, APD (Autorite de protection des donnees) has issued a fine of 50,000 euros on an unnamed social network for collection and use of personal data through an "invite contacts" function without a valid legal basis.
