# Global privacy regulators joint letter to video conferencing service providers

An open letter signed by privacy commissioners of Canada, Australia, Gibraltar, Hong Kong, Switzerland, and the United Kingdom is sent to video conferencing service providers like Microsoft, Cisco, Zoom, House Party, and Google.

In the letter the regulators have urged the companies to mitigate privacy risks to protect users' personal information and ensure compliance with data protection and privacy laws globally.

The letter calls for responses from service provider by 30 September 2020 demonstrating actions taken by them in the design and delivery of their services.

## Uber drivers' GDPR complaint

The App Drivers and Couriers Union (ADCU) has launched a legal action against Uber for violating the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) obligations. ADCU has argued that Uber has failed to provide access to the data and how the algorithm is used for automated decision making and profiling of the drivers.

## Facebook USD 650m biometric settlement

Just after months of rejecting a proposed USD 550 million settlement the District Court of the Northern California signaled approval of USD 650 million settlement claims against Facebook, Inc. for violation under the Illinois Biometric Information Privacy Act.

It was alleged that Facebook failed to get consent of users before compiling a database of people's facial templates it uses to identify the photos for tagging suggestions.



# Transunion credit bureau fined by Columbian DPA

CIFIN, a subsidiary of TransUnion has been fined 702 million Colombian pesos by Columbian data protection authority for violating consumer privacy of 288753 Columbian citizens.





## Tiktok fined by South Korean regulator

The telecommunication regulator of South Korea, Korea Communications Commission issued fine of WON 186 million on Tiktok, a video sharing app for collecting data of children under the age of 14 without parental consent and transferring the data overseas without notification.



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
