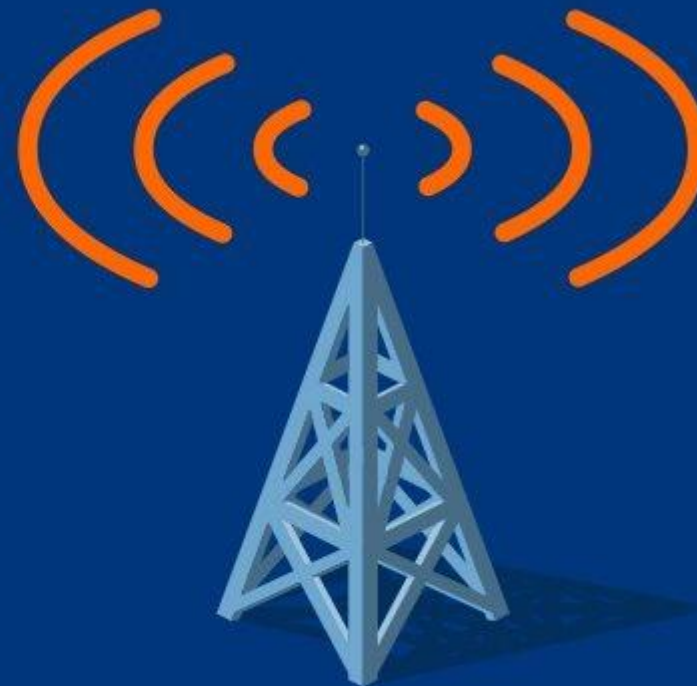

## Telco fined by Romanian data watchdog

The National Supervisory Authority for Personal Data Processing in Romania, fined Telecom Company, Telekom Romania Mobile Communications S.A. as it failed to adopt adequate technical and organizational security measures which led to unauthorized disclosure of personal data affecting 99,210 customers. As a result, the Authority fined the company with RON 63,748 for violations under the GDPR and Law concerning the Processing of Personal Data and the Protection of Privacy in the Electronic Communications Sector.



## Chinese govt issues notices to app developers

In a bid to implement and improve the personal data protection regime China's Ministry of Industry and Information Technology issued notices to country's leading app developer companies, for not rectifying their data protection and privacy measures. App developers such as iFlyTek Peiyin, Tencent were among the 136 app makers which had received notice from the ministry. The companies were asked to rectify and correct defects in their data security measures or face action.

## **Garante fines municipality and mobility services**

The Italian Data Protection Authority (Garante) in its newsletter announced that it has fined Municipality of Rome with EUR 350,000 and the mobility services company with EUR 60,000 for failing adequately safeguard personal data of citizens who were permitted to enter traffic restricted areas. Garante in its investigation noted that the access permits displayed on the cars had a QR code which could be read with app installed in smartphones and therefore personal data of the holder could be accessed by anyone through the app.

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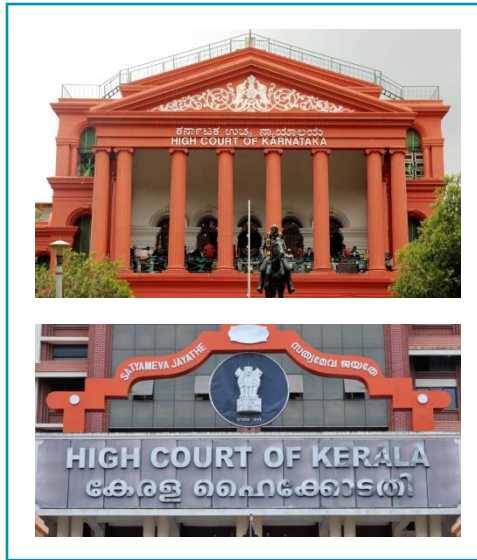
