

Google complies CNIL's injunction order

CNIL, the French Data Protection Authority decided to close its injunction order, after it was confirmed that Google had taken up corrective measures in relation to its cookie violations. As per the order Google has deployed a cookie information banner and now cookies are subject to consent. In this regard, CNIL had previously fined Google EUR 100 million for cookie information violations.

Iceland Authority fines education platform

The Data Protection Authority in Iceland (Personuvernd) announced its decision to fine InfoMentor, an education consultancy and technology platform, as it failed to implement adequate security measures, due to which personal data of 424 children was illegally exposed. As a result, Personuvernd issued a fine of ISK 3,500,000 for violation under various provisions of the GDPR.

Chinese watchdog acts against illegal data collection

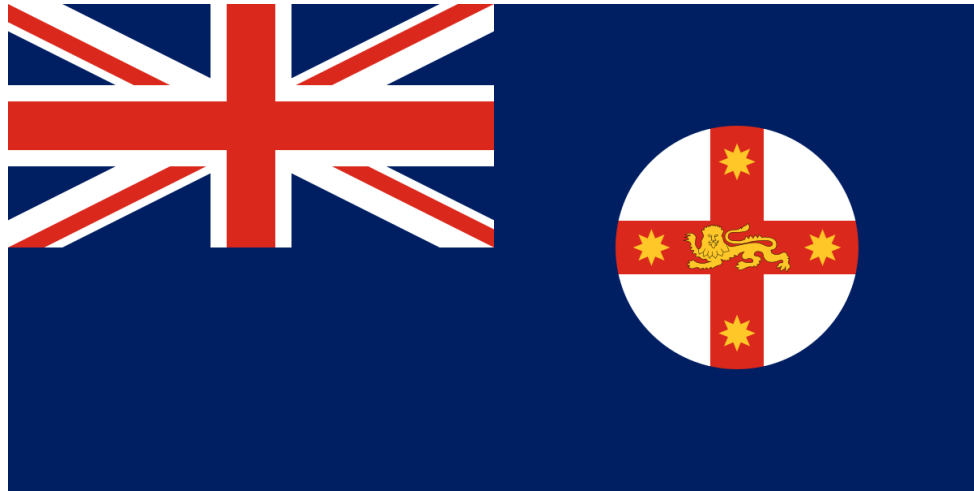
The Cyberspace Affairs Commission of China issued a notice against 33 apps to stop illegal collection and use of personal data. The Commission had received complaints regarding these apps alleging that these apps collect data without consent and excessively than necessary. The Commission has given a 10 days' notice for the app developers to rectify their data collection practices and report.

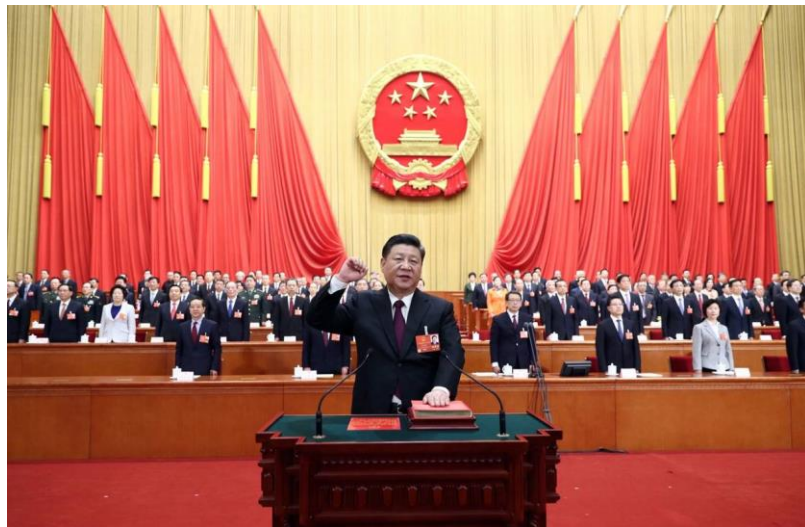

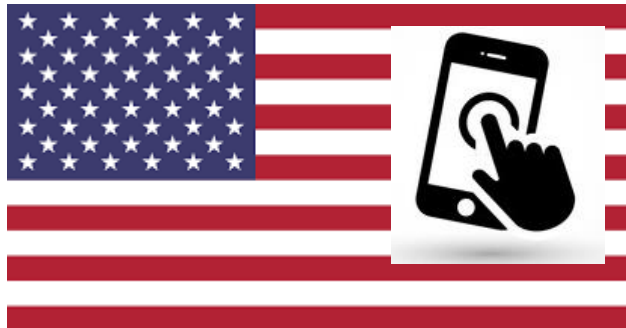
