- Spanish data protection authority released a blog titled “AI: System vs Processing, Means vs Purposes”.

- Hungary’s data protection authority issued a fine of HUF 5 million for violation of the General Data Protection Regulation.

- Bill regarding compliance requirements for data brokers was introduced to the California Senate.
- Washington’s My Health My Data Act was passed by the State Senate.
- A bill regarding the statute of limitations under the California Consumer Privacy Act of 2018 was referred to the Privacy and Consumer Protection and Judiciary Committees.
- The Senator for Missouri announced a bill prohibiting the operation of TikTok in the US.
